Scholarship is dependent upon a 3.0 GPA achieved at current school. Tuition Assistance is contingent upon first semester grades showing a cumulative 3.0 GPA. Scholarship funds and tuition assistance will be made payable to the school and will be mailed directly to the institution. Failure to provide information or to achieve the required GPA may result in the scholarship payment being delayed or withdrawn. Former winners may reapply if they meet all requirements. Minimum scholarship award will be \$1,000.
